Paid Warm Up The intention w PWU is to give the horses and riders the chance to get to know the arena. Then number of Pleasure entries per day is limited to 20. The number of Trail entries per day is limited to 30. Time allotted for trail is 6 minutes per two riders. If you don't tell the Show management, your team-mate we will select one for you. No horse is allowed more than one trail slot per day, but a rider may have several entries.

All Breed All Breed Classes are judged applying the AQHA rule book. And regarding mouthpieces Novice rules Apply i e a snaffle can be used independent of horses age.

Walk/Trot W/T classes (All Breed) are for non-Pro riders only. Horse and Rider combination entering in corresponding classes with Lope (All Breed, APHA, AQHA and NSBA) may not start W/T. The intention is to give riders who can't or don't want to lope an opportunity to show. Its not intended as a warm-up class. For that purpose, there are PWU.

NSBA NSBA classes require a membership in NSBA Scandinavia or NSBA USA for rider and owner. Classes marked "only NSBA-S" require a membership in NSBA Scandinavia and doesn't count towards any ranking in the US for more info see www.nsba.se. NSBA Rulebook apply.

Trail If the weather allows, we will try using the outdoor arena

Prizes, Prize Money, Ribbons, Medals and sponsored prices in NSBA Classes

55% of entry fees are paid back as prize money to an account provided by the participant, after the show.

6 Ribbons will be awarded in all classes. In the NSBA classes Gold Silver and Bronze Ribbons will be awarded for 1-3 placings and the traditional Maroon ribbons for 4-6 placings

Scandinavian Championship Medals will be awarded at a special Awards Ceremony Saturday night.

Sponsored prices are randomly given out among the participants with a result in the class (non-DQ).

Only NSBA S members compete for NSBA-S Year End Awards.

Only NSBA USA members compete for NSBA USA's ranking.

NSBA 1 & 2-year-old cup.

Results from the Cup Classes are aggregated and a total winner, based on the horses is awarded. In addition to the best horse the best horse in the other age-group will also be awarded. I e if a 2YO wins then also the best 1 YO will be awarded and vice versa.

Awards Ceremonies. The contestants are asked to participate with their horses. If not participating any sponsored prices will be awarded another entry. When Classes are run concurrently (APHA SPB/Regular) one set of ribbons will be awarded, but points will be given separately) Concurrent Classes will be run when applicable.

Dinner and Medal Ceremony.

Adjacent to the Saturday Night Dinner Medals for Scandinavian Champion will be Awarded in the NSBA-classes at approx. 20.00 (and will be open to all, Dinner is not mandatory).

Awards Trophies will be awarded in the following Categories

Arrival at the earliest at 3 pm Wednesday June 5th

Vaccination All horses must have a current vaccination against A2 Virus. Vaccination Regime may not have been entered into within less than 10 days before the show. Certification of Vaccination shall be presented upon Request.

Free Riding The Arena will be available in most breaks and Lunch breaks as well as before, after and during nighttime when classes are not on. See special information in arena regarding any limitations on this.

Show Office Opens at 19:00 Wednesday June 5th. Only entries made on official forms are allowed. No text, FB or Chat messages are accepted. Office is generally open until 1 hour after the last class of the day.

Late or Additional Entries Already entered horses may add classes up until 1 hour before the class. If entry lists have been issued the additional Entry will start first. The ambition is to have entry lists published 2 hours before start, for the first class of the day lists will be published the evening before. Late Entries to the first class of the day shall be made the day before.

Refunds Class Fees received by NSBA-S: 100% of Class fees (not Entry Fees) are refunded if a Veterinary or Medical Doctor Certificate issued before or on the same day as the class entered **is presented to the NSBA**

Entry Numbers The correct number shall be visible/worn when riding or longeing the horse on the show grounds. If using numbers not issued by the NSBA, the used numbers should be at least the same size as those provided. Numbers provided by the NSBA shall be returned to the show office or an additional 100 kr will be charged

Ethical: The Show management applies the rules and regulations issued by the AQHA regarding treatment and animal welfare on the Showgrounds. Horse and Rider can be shown off the showgrounds based on abuse or not applying with show management instructions. Any fees paid in will be forfeit.

Food The restaurant will be open for breakfast, lunch and dinner from June 6th 7 am until June 9th 3 pm.

Photography: By entering the show you give NSBA the right to make photos of your participation in the show. Anyone may take photos at the show, but only NSBA-S or by NSBA-S appointed party may commercially sell or trade photos of the show.
