<b>Showrules and general information</b>			
<b>Paid Warm Up</b>	<p>The intention with PWU is to give the horses and riders the chance to get to know the arena.</p> <p>The number of Pleasure/Hunter entries per day is limited to 20.</p> <p>The number of Trail entries per day is limited to 30. Time allotted for trail is 6 minutes per two riders. <b>On site, you and your teammate, will be able to book your timeslot on a specific list – but you must enter the PWU as usual in showoffice!</b> No horse is allowed more than one trail slot per day, but a rider may have several entries.</p>		
<b>All Breed- Open</b>	<p>Open to all horses and riders/handlers.</p> <p>All Breed Classes are judged applying the AQHA rulebook. Regarding mouthpieces Level 1 rules Apply - meaning a snaffle can be used independent of horseage.</p> <p>No memberships required to enter All breed classes.</p>		
<b>All Breed - Amateur /Youth</b>	<p>Open to amateur/youth riders according to AQHA/APHA rulebook.</p> <p>Amateur rider cannot make income on training other riders or other people horses. Simply said- you are riding your own (or leased horse) for fun!</p> <p>Youth rider – riders who are up to 18 years old. You show youth trough out the whole year of wich you turn 18.</p>		
<b>All breed - Novice Amateur/Youth Walk/Trot</b>	<p>A class where patterns are easy, containing only walk&amp;trot(jog).</p> <p>Horse and Rider combination entering in corresponding classes with Lope (All Breed, APHA, AQHA and NSBA) may not start W/T.</p> <p>The intention of W/T is to give riders who can't or don't want to lope an opportunity to show.</p>

<b>All breed – Novice Amateur /Youth</b>	<p>Riders who would be eligible for AQHA Level 1/APHA Novice is eligible for All breed Novice classes. Riders eligible for WRAS D&amp;C level and lower levels.</p> <p>A class with slightly simpler pattern than the ordinary amateur/youth class.</p>
<b>NSBA</b>	<p>NSBA classes require a membership in NSBA Scandinavia <i>or</i> NSBA USA for rider <u>and</u> owner. Classes marked “only NSBA-S” require a membership in NSBA Scandinavia and doesn’t count towards any ranking in the US for more info see <a href="http://www.nsba.se">www.nsba.se</a>.</p> <p>NSBA Rulebook apply.</p>
<b>NSBA Young Horsecup</b>	<p>2 &amp; 3 yr olds are eligible, for rules regarding younghorsecup see specific document for younghorsecup rules.</p> <p>Horses entering younghorsecup are prohibited to be ridden on showgrounds!</p> <p>Entering young horsecup requires NSBA-s membership for owner and exhibitor.</p> <p>Cupwinners will be rewarded with medals.</p>
<b>Prizes, Prize Money, Ribbons and sponsored prices in NSBA Classes</b>	<p>55 % of entry fees are paid back as prize money to an account provided by the participant, after the show.</p> <p>3 Ribbons will be awarded in all classes. For a NSBA class to be a Celebration class it must have at least five entries who are member of NSBA Scandinavia, otherwise it will be considered as a general NSBA class.</p> <p>For Celebration-classes: exclusive NSBA Celebration ribbons - Gold, Silver and Bronze Ribbons will be awarded for 1-3 placings. To be crowned NSBA Scandinavian Celebration Winner NSBA-s membership is required!</p> <p>For NSBA-classes in general NSBA ribbons will be rewarded to 1-3 placings as standard in NSBA classes.</p> <p>Sponsored prices are randomly given out among the participants with a result in the class (non-DQ).</p> <p>Only NSBA S members compete for NSBA-S Year End Awards ranking.</p> <p>Only NSBA USA members compete for NSBA USA’s ranking.</p>
<b>AQHA</b>	<p>AQHA membership for rider and owner is required for showing in AQHA classes. Ribbons for 1-6 place, sponsored by Swedish Quarter Horse Ass.</p> <p>Preferably memberships are already done by the time you come to show but it can be arranged with at showsite as well, payments are if so done by your creditcard directly to AQHA.</p>
<b>APHA</b>	<p>APHA membership for rider and owner is required for showing in APHA classes. Ribbons for 1-6 place, sponsored by Swedish Paint Horse Ass. &amp; NSBA’s.</p>

<b>Trail</b>	If the weather allows, we will try using the outdoor arena. It will be announced at showsite if so.
<b>Award Ceremonies</b>	The contestants are asked to participate with their horses. If not participating any sponsored prizes will be awarded another entry.
<b>Show awards</b>	Medals will be awarded in the following Categories <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• NSBA Scandinavian Open All Around</li> <li>• NSBA Scandinavia Youth All Around</li> <li>• NSBA Scandinavian Non Pro All Around</li> </ul> <p>Show awards may be complementary by sponsored prizes until show.</p>
<b>Arrival</b>	Arrival earliest at 2 pm Wednesday June 1 <sup>st</sup> . Earlier needs to be booked with Grevagården. <a href="mailto:grevagarden@telia.com">grevagarden@telia.com</a> (+46-703-57 68 01)
<b>Vaccination</b>	All horses must have a current vaccination against A2 Virus. Vaccination Regime may not have been entered into within less than 10 days before the show. Certification of Vaccination shall be presented upon Request.
<b>Free Riding</b>	The showarena will be available in most breaks as well as before, after the show and during nighttime when classes are not on if other is not stated. See special information in arena regarding any limitations on this.
<b>Show Office</b>	Opens at 19:00 Wednesday June 1 <sup>st</sup> . Only entries made on official forms are allowed. No text, FB or Chat messages are accepted. Office is generally open until 1 hour after the last class of the day.
<b>Late or Additional Entries</b>	Already entered horses may add classes up until 1 hour before the class. If entry lists have been issued the additional Entry will start first. The ambition is to have entry lists published 2 hours before start, for the first class of the day lists will be published the evening before. <u>Late entries to the first class of the day shall be made the day before.</u>  Entries should be made on the official entryform, no entries made on facebook, messenger, textmessage in what ever form will be accepted!
<b>Refunds</b>	Class Fees received by NSBA-S: 100% of Class fees (not entry fees) are refunded if a Veterinary or Medical Doctor Certificate issued before or on the same day as the class entered is presented to the NSBA's.
<b>Entry Numbers</b>	The correct number shall be visible/worn when riding or longing the horse on the show grounds. If using numbers not issued by the NSBA, the used numbers should be at least the same size as those provided.  Numbers provided by the NSBA shall be returned to the show office or an additional 100 kr will be charged.
<b>Ethical</b>	The Show management applies the rules and regulations issued by the AQHA regarding treatment and animal welfare on the Showgrounds. Horse and Rider can be shown off the showgrounds based on abuse or not applying with show management instructions.  <u>Any fees paid in will be forfeit.</u>

<b>Horsewelfare</b>	<p>Considering horses wellbeing and welfare showmanagement recommends you select your classes carefully in light of not overshoot your horse.</p> <p>Athletes needs sleep to perform well, therefore we aim to keep the lights out in the stalls between midnight and 4am.</p>

<b>Important information</b>	<p>All Paperwork; Registration Certificates, Ownership, Memberships, (NSBA, AQHA, APHA), ROM for Performance Halter (AQHA), must be cleared with the Show office <b><u>before first entry!</u></b></p> <p>The order of the classes and the setup of classes offered is subject to change based on the number of horses entered, in accordance with the rulebook.</p> <p>Halter classes may be combined according to the rulebook.</p> <p>AQHA Junior and Senior classes may be combined into an AA class according to the rulebook.</p> <p>SPB and Regular APHA may be ran as an "all Paint registries class" according to the rulebook.</p>	
<b>Patterns</b>	<p>Patterns will be published one week before the show.</p>	
<b>Reservations</b>	<p><b>Learning by doing due to our economic situation; NSBA Scandinavia reserve the right to cancel the show if it turns out that the show will not make ends meet economically. This decision will, in that case, be made between last entry date and at latest one week before show and will be announced on website and social media.
