Competition rules and general information	
Paid warm up	<p>The purpose of PWU is to give the horses and riders the chance to get to know the competition arena.</p> <p>Trail PWU will, weather permitting, be conducted under new conditions on the outdoor track. Information about this will be posted closer to the competition when we know what the weather looks like.</p> <p>In case it rains and the trail will be held in, times for the PWU trail will be posted on site and social media during the competition.</p>
"Cross enter"	<p>In NSBA, AQHA, APHA, a horse cannot cross enter in the following classes, regardless of the association;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trail and Ranch Trail • Ranch Riding and Western Pleasure • Ranch Rail and Western Pleasure • Trail and Trail in hand (APHA) <p>A horse that <u>only starts</u> all breeds can "cross enter" in all classes.</p>
All breeds classes, general rules	<p>No membership is required to participate in all breeds classes.</p> <p>All all-breeds classes are judged according to the AQHA rulebook. When it comes to bit rules, Level 1 rules apply - which means that a snaffle bit can be used regardless of the horse's age.</p> <p>In HMS & HSE, railwork is discontinued!</p> <p>Below are class-specific rules for different levels of all breeds classes</p>
All Breed- Open	Open to all horses and riders/handlers.
Allbred Novice Horse & Novice Rider Walk&Trot	<p>A class where the patterns only contain walk&trot (jog).</p> <p>An opportunity to start green horses regardless of age without having to gallop.</p> <p>An opportunity for Novice riders to compete regardless of the horse's skill level.</p> <p>Combinations that enter the corresponding classes with canter (All Breed, APHA, AQHA and NSBA) are not allowed to start W/T.</p> <p>The purpose of W/T is to give riders who can't or don't want to gallop an opportunity to compete.</p>
Allbred Circuit Champion Walk&Trot	The best combination in the all breed walk &trot classes will be rewarded with a nice trophy sponsored by NB Showhorses.
All breed – Novice Nonpro	Riders who would be eligible for AQHA Level 1 / APHA Novice are eligible for Allbred Novice classes. Riders who are eligible for WRAS D&C level and lower levels.

NSBA	<p>NSBA classes require membership in NSBA Scandinavia <i>or</i> NSBA USA for riders <u>and</u> owners. Classes marked "NSBA-S only" require membership in NSBA Scandinavia and do not count towards any rankings in the United States, for more information see www.nsba.se.</p> <p>Horses starting the NSBA class must be registered in NSBA USA.</p> <p>Registration must be completed before the competition and can not be done at site! Information about registration can be found on the website, Requirements for showing – National Snaffle Bit Association Scandinavia (nsba.se)</p> <p>NSBA USA rulebook applies.</p>
NSBA-S Young horsecup	<p>Horses 2 – 3 years old are eligible to start in the Young Horse Cup. Rules for the Young Horse Cup, see specific document on nsba.se</p> <p>Horses competing in the young horsecup are forbidden to be ridden at the competition venue!</p> <p>Starting in the Young Horse Cup requires NSBA-S membership for owners and participants. The Young Horse Cup is sponsored with a nice trophy sponsored by WPL Quarter & Painthorses.</p>
NSBA Ranch Cup	<p>Entries in NSBA Open-classes in Ranch Trail, Ranch Riding and Ranch Rail are automatically contender in NSBA Ranch Cup.</p> <p>Ranch Cup is sponsored by Western Horsemen</p>
NSBA Show Highpoint	<p>The highpoint title for the most winning horse/rider is awarded in the following categories.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NSBA Open all around (The horse regardless of which rider is riding) • NSBA Youth all around (The rider regardless of which horse they are riding) • NSBA Amateur all around (The rider regardless of which horse they ride) <i>Sponsored by Unna Katz.</i> <p>NSBA's Young Horse classes do not count towards the Highpoint title. Ranch classes count towards the Highpoint title. Amateur and Youth riders earn their points in Non-pro classes.</p>
Prizes, prize money, ribbons and sponsored prizes in NSBA classes	<p>55% of the class fee will be refunded as prize money to the account provided by the participant/horse owner, after the show. Added money in the class is added to the pot with the class fee and distributed according to the current table.</p> <p>3 rosettes will be awarded in all NSBA classes.</p> <p>For an NSBA class to be a Celebration class, it must have at least five</p>

	<p>starters who are members of NSBA Scandinavia, otherwise it will be considered a regular NSBA class.</p> <p>For Celebration classes: exclusive NSBA Celebration rosettes - Gold, Silver and Bronze will be awarded for 1-3 placings. To be crowned NSBA Scandinavian Celebration Winner, NSBA-S membership is required!</p> <p>For NSBA classes without Celebration status, regular NSBA rosettes will be awarded 1-3 placed.</p> <p>Only NSBA S members compete for the NSBA-S Year End Awards rankings.</p> <p>Only NSBA USA members compete for the NSBA USA rankings.</p>
AQHA	<p>AQHA membership for riders and owners is required to show in AQHA classes.</p> <p>Ideally, membership is already ready when you arrive at the competition site, but it can be arranged on site as well, payments are then made from your credit card directly to AQHA.</p>
AQHA L1 Open Circuit Champion	<p>The best horse participating in L1 Open classes (Green) will be rewarded with a circuit champion title and receive a nice trophy sponsored by NB Showhorses.</p>
APHA	<p>APHA membership for riders and owners is required for competitors in APHA classes.</p> <p>APHA classes are arranged in collaboration with Swedish Paint Horse Ass.</p> <p>Ideally, memberships are already in place when you come to compete but it can be arranged on site as well, payments are then made from your credit card directly to APHA.</p>
APHA Green Circuit Champion	<p>The best horse participating in Green classes will be rewarded with a circuit champion title and receive a nice trophy sponsored by NB Showhorses.</p>
Botabo Gård Celebration Trail cup	<p>Trail cup in 3 runs during the weekend with added money of 10.000SEK sponsored by Botabo Gård, Linn Andersson.</p> <p>Patterns for the trail cup are posted 1 hour before the start of the class.</p> <p>Patterns are on Open Level.</p> <p>AQHA rules apply regarding bit-rules. Seniorhorses are supposed to be shown in a bridle on one hand!</p> <p>The classes are judged by both judges and the total score is added together from the two and all cup rides during the weekend to crown a cup winner.</p> <p>Participants must ride all 3 runs, in case of a tie, a re-ride will be applied. The combination of horse and rider should be the same during all rides. Special cup ribbon and prize money for first-third placed.</p>

	<p>1st place 6000 SEK 2nd place 2500 SEK 3rd place 1500 SEK</p> <p>The number of participants in the cup is limited to 20 horse and rider combinations. <i>First come, first served! Paid registration = registered for the cup.</i></p>
Awards	<p>To make the show more efficient, award ceremonies for multiple classes can be held at the same time. Of course, we prefer that you participate with your horse, but if the wait is long, we understand that you choose to let your horse rest in the stable. It is then okay to participate without a horse, but you must be neatly dressed if you as a rider participate.</p> <p>Pay attention to the instructions regarding the award ceremony and leave the arena as soon as possible after the award ceremony so that the next class can begin. Do not stop at the gate!</p>
Trail	<p>We hope that the weather will be with us and that some classes will be able to be run on the outdoor track in parallel with classes indoors to streamline the competition days and thus save all the long competition days.</p> <p>Otherwise, and if necessary, suitable classes can be held in the old riding hall to prepare the large riding hall for the next class.</p>
Arrival	<p>Arrival no earlier than 14:00 on Wednesday 29 May. Earlier arrivals need to be booked at Grevagården. grevagarden@telia.com (+46-703-57 68 01)</p>
Vaccination & Horse Passports	<p>All horses must be vaccinated according to the Swedish Equestrian Federation's recommendations. Vaccination cards must be presented upon request.</p> <p>The horse's passport must be able to be presented at the competition venue.</p>
Free riding	<p>The show arena will be available for free riding in most intermissions as well as before and after the show unless otherwise specified. Please refer to specific information in the venue for any restrictions on this.</p>
Showoffice	<p>Opens no later than 19.00 on Wednesday 29 May. Other times will be posted on site and social media.</p> <p>Only entries made on the official entry form are allowed. No text, FB, or chat messages will be accepted. The secretariat is usually open until 1 hour after the last class of the day.</p>
Late entries	<p>Already registered horses can add classes up to 1 hour before the class. If start lists have been issued, late entries start first.</p> <p>The ambition is to get start lists published 2 hours before the start, for today's first class lists will be published the night before.</p> <p><u>Late registration for today's first class must be done the day before.</u></p> <p>Entry must be done on the official entry form. no notifications made on facebook, messenger, SMS will be accepted!</p>

Refunds & Payout of Prize Money	<p>100% of the class fees (not entry fees) will be refunded if a veterinary or medical certificate issued on or on the same day the specified class is presented to the NSBA-S.</p> <p>Account numbers must be submitted to NSBA-S upon request after the competition. Submitted account details will be deleted after NSBA-S has refunded/disbursed money.</p>
Backnumber	<p>The correct backnumber must be visible when the horse is ridden or lunged at the competition venue. If backnumbers not provided by NSBA-S are used, the backnumber used shall be at least as large as those provided.</p> <p>Backnumber provided by NSBA-S should be returned to showoffice. Non-returned back number will be charged SEK 100.</p>
Warmup- & collect ring	<p>No horses/riders/trainers/spectators standing in the entrance/exit and collecting ring! Think about safety! No hay allowed in the riding hall/riding arena!</p>
Ethics	<p>The horse must be at least three years old to be ridden in the competition area. Mares that have reached 7 months gestation and/or have foals by the side, may not be ridden in the competition area. Inhumane treatment of horses in the competition area will result in suspension from the competition.</p> <p>All riding will be monitored and excessive use of spurs, bits, whips or similar will result in a warning and then suspension.</p> <p><u>All fees paid will be forfeited and will not be refunded in the event of rejection.</u></p> <p>The competition management recommends helmets for youth riders when riding on showsite.</p> <p>Doping tests may occur during the competition.</p>
Horse welfare	<p>Considering the welfare and well-being of horses, show management recommends that you choose your classes carefully regarding not over-competing your horse.</p>
Restaurant and food	<p>To be presented at a later stage. Keep an eye on NSBA.se and our social media.</p>
Photographer	<p>Photographer Magnus Billberg will be there. Contact the photographer for inspection and purchase of images.</p> <p>By participating, you grant NSBA-S the right to photograph and use images of your participation in the show. The images can be used on social media, the website and other commercial contexts. In cases where you do not wish to be photographed officially, this must be specifically stated.</p>

Important information	All paperwork; Certificate of registration, ownership, membership NSBA/AQHA/APHA, must be in order with the secretariat <u>before the first start!</u> The order of classes is subject to change based on the number of horses in accordance with the rulebook. AQHA Halter classes can be combined according to the rulebook. AQHA Junior and Senior classes can be combined into one AA class according to the rulebook. SPB and Regular APHA are performed as an "all Paint registries class" where it allows according to the rulebook. APHA Rail classes (WP and HuS) are conducted concurrent-significant that Solids and Regular paints ride at the same time. The class is judged and the teams are placed. The results are then administered so that a prize ceremony for each breed/class is carried out.
Pattern	The ambition is for patterns to be available before the application deadline.
Reservations	NSBA Scandinavia reserves the right to cancel the show if it turns out that the show will not work out financially in advance. This decision will be made between the last registration date and no later than one week before the competition and will be announced on the website and social media. In case of cancellation, any fees paid to NSBA-S will be refunded.
